The total of orphans that ACC has adopted to date number around 8000.

I.Introduction

Wan Jin has a very clear voice and articulate pronunciation of Chinese Mandarin. She was one of the orphans adopted by Amitofo Care Center. Wan Jin survived from starvation and poverty and now shares with the world her talented voice thanks to the selfless love and consideration from Taiwan.

ACC is an international nongovernmental organization founded by Taiwanese Buddhist Monk, Venerable Master Huei-Li. For the past ten years, they have established orphanages and affiliated schools in Namibia, Malawi, Lesotho, and Swaziland. There are three more schools under construction in Mozambique, the capital of Malawi, Lilongwe, and Mandela View in South Africa that are to be completed in autumn 2016.

Currently 900 orphans live inside the first three orphanage schools. Through different local organizations, ACC also directly supports another 8,000 orphans in the region.

ACC teaches children under its direct care, local language, English, Chinese Mandarin, and Kung Fu in efforts to prepare future pillars and leaders in the African societies.



Since 2007, orphans from ACC orphanages travel outside of Southern African countries to have charitable performances to sensitize the world about this cause and solicit help.

They also go out to show gratitude to people that have helped them.

In 2014 they traveled through the support of Republic of China (Taiwan) and Taiwanese Chambers of Commerce in other countries. The children have visited Taiwan, Chinese Mainland, Hong Kong, Thailand, Japan, the United States, Brazil, Paraguay, Canada, Mauritius, and South Africa and were very well received.

In 2015 they visited four German cities: Dusseldorf, Berlin, Hamburg, and Frankfurt, where they generated a lot of tears.

This summer of 2016 they are scheduled to visit 13 cities in the United States and Canada.

II. GOALS

The Republic of China (Taiwan) is widely recognized as a peacemaker, promoter of cultural exchange, new technology, as well as the leader of standard bearer of Chinese culture.

Through assistance from general public and government agencies in Taiwan, these young and adorable African children can be saved from starvation and poverty.

Taiwan used to receive economic and military assistance from the United States during the 1950 and 1960s. Now, Taiwan is able to stand up and reciprocate the help she received to aid other countries.

Those who have donated and devoted their time and efforts to helping truly believe it is our responsibility to perpetuate Chinese culture and promote Taiwan's spirit, its tenacity and resilience.



We also hope that through their learning of classic Chinese odes they appreciate the legacy left to us by our ancestors.

For the past 60 years, Taiwan has developed herself from postcolonial economy to the 20th largest economy in the world. Taiwan, with her 14,000sq/mi area, only occupies about 23% of the size State of Florida with a crowded population of 23 million. It is now the 9th largest trading partner of the United States.

Through ACC's performances we also hope people around the world can witness Taiwan's contribution to global villages in the humanitarian assistance aspect, after all, we are family.

We feel ACC children can contribute to the development of Africa. We also hope their visits around the world widen their perspectives and vision, leading to future cooperation between and other parts of the world.
